

**2017 NTLTC Scholarship Instructions**  
Deadline for Application: March 10, 2017

To apply for an NTLTC Scholarship you must be a senior and a registered student in the 2017 NTLTC Convention. The scholarships are for those who have demonstrated leadership in church, school and community. You are required to send two references recommending you for a scholarship—one from a church leader (e.g., youth minister, preacher, elder, or Bible class teacher) and one from a school leader (e.g., teacher, coach, principal, or counselor). How well you describe your leadership contributions will be a very important factor. Participation in an activity is not evidence of leadership.

NTLTC Honor Scholarships

Richard Parker, Elaine Shaver and David Shelburne were very involved in LTC for a number of years. The scholarships given in their names is to honor the example they were in service and leadership. This award is based on a student's Christian example, financial need, and demonstrated leadership qualities. NTLTC determines the yearly award of these scholarships and will notify the students who are awarded these scholarships. The Richard Parker Scholarship is given to both a male and a female applicant. The Elaine Shaver Scholarship will be awarded a female applicant and the David Shelburne Scholarship will be awarded to a male applicant.

Christian College Scholarships

NTLTC oversees the distribution of several scholarships in connection with several christian universities. NTLTC collects the scholarship applications and awards them appropriately to the students attending these universities. Each school will provide NTLTC with a certificate when a scholarship is awarded. This certificate is put in the awards packet for each church.

Note: Most leadership scholarships from Christian colleges are not combined with other leadership scholarships. They are, however, usually used in combination with other types of scholarships (such as academic or athletic scholarships). Consult the college for details.

Checklist for Online Application:

1. Write your essay describing your leadership contributions to your church, school, and community. Save this essay, using your name as the file name, in one of the following formats; Microsoft Word, PDF, RTF, TXT.
2. Visit the NTLTC website at [www.ntlctc.org](http://www.ntlctc.org) and click the link to 2015 Scholarship Application.
3. Complete the form providing us with the appropriate information and attaching your essay using the button on the last page.
4. Please direct the individuals that are writing your letters of reference to the NTLTC website and the Recommendation Submission link. Please inform them that they will need to have their letters typed and saved, using your full name, ready to be attached upon completion of their form.
